Easter Provision

As part of our commitment to providing care for children of key workers and vulnerable children, we are offering reduced education provision during the Easter break, from Monday 6th April to Friday 17th April, Bank Holidays and weekends excluded. These Easter sessions will be held at **Pinchbeck East C E Primary School and Spalding Primary School**, to provide continuity of our current provision. **Surfleet children will, therefore, still attend Pinchbeck.**

Please note the government's advice that, wherever possible, everyone must stay at home to help stop the spread of coronavirus, including children of key workers unless child care cannot be provided at home.

The provision on offer will be run by Elite Sport Academy who provide P.E and sport in all our three schools and whose coaches know our children well. There will be a wide range of activities on offer each day including art and crafts, games, fitness challenges and many more. The coaches will follow school procedure and protocols regarding safe distancing and handwashing. A member of each school's leadership team will be on call daily.

The sessions will run from 8:45am to 3:30pm each day. Unfortunately, our lunch provider is unable to provide lunches during the Easter break; you will, therefore, need to send your child with a packed lunch and a drink.
