With the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS) application deadline (30th June) fast approaching, it is crucial that eligible parents apply to the Scheme themselves and check whether they need to do so on behalf of their children. Eligible children are required to have an application in their own right and no child of any age is covered by a parent's application to the EUSS.
