There is no limit on how many gifts you can buy, so why not treat Uncles & Granddads too.

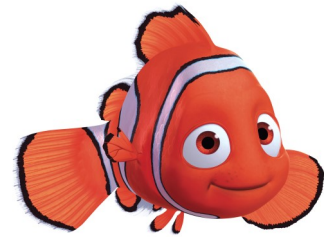
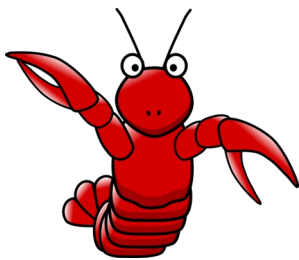
Please note that gifts can only be purchased through ParentPay. Payments will be available from the 24th May 2021 up to and including the 6th June 2021.

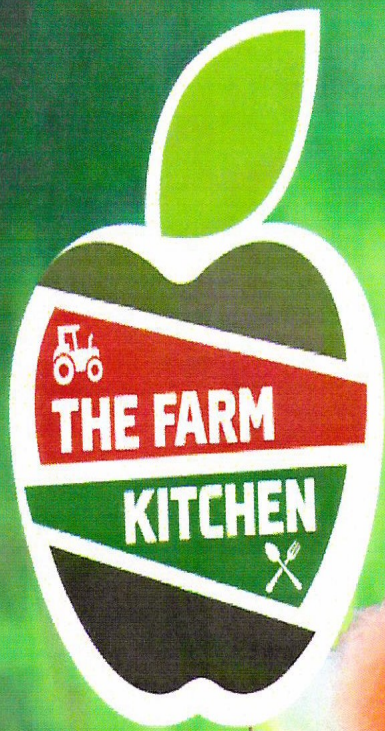
