Competition Dates

The Refuse Artwork competition will run from 9:00 Saturday 27th March 2021 until 5:00pm Monday 19th April 2021. Late entries will not be accepted.

Entries

- i. The competition is free to enter.
- ii. Completed artwork can be posted to the Waste Services Team at South Holland District Council, West Marsh Road, Spalding, Lincs, PE11 2BB.
- iii. Child's name, age and parent or guardian contact telephone number must be written on a separate piece of paper enclosed in the envelope with the artwork.
- iv. Artwork should be on A4 paper in landscape view.
- v. Participants may only enter one piece of artwork into the competition.

Entries must be completed by children who attend a primary school in the South Holland District and they must have their parent's or guardian's permission to enter.

Winning entries

- i. The winning entry of artwork will be chosen by SHDC.
- ii. The Winner will be contacted via the details provided on the entry form.

The winning entry will be notified by 30th April 2021.

Entry forms will be stored in secure locations in accordance with the council's Data Protection Policy and Procedure for the duration of the competition. Once the winners have been chosen and the project is complete all entry forms and details will be destroyed.
