Orders need to be made by Tuesday lunchtime for the following week. All menus are there up until half-term. Universal Free School Meals are for children in Reception, year 1 and year 2. Parents of these children and Pupil Premium children still need to go on to Parentpay to choose their meals. Anyone having issues with ordering should contact the school office.

Don't forget—order by <u>Tuesday</u> for the following Monday! I send the menu numbers to the kitchen on a Tuesday before I leave the office. If any parent tries to order after 1.00pm, their child will not be added to the list as it will be too late!
