Arrangements for academic year 2022-2023

With the end of this school year fast approaching, I thought it timely to update you on some changes that will be taking place from September 5th 2022.

Classes for September 2022

We have decided to make slight changes to the year groups in each class for the next academic year. As there has been so much disruption to the children's learning over the past two years, we wanted to do everything we could to ensure that all of our children can make the most of their time with us. Now more than ever, relationships are key to children's happiness and learning and so, in order for the children to make the very best progress they can, we have decided on the following class arrangements for September 2022:

Willow Class

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 (25 children) Miss Bates and Mrs Craft

Maple Class

Year 3 and Year 4 (20 children) Miss Cook and Mrs Hellen

Oak Class

Year 5 and Year 6 (21 children) Mr Price, Mrs Hooker, Miss Thomson and Mrs Wilkinson

I am sure you will agree that this will provide much needed consistency for our children and I have no doubt that the children will be thrilled to have the same staff team again in most classes!

Staffing Changes

Miss Stringer will be starting her maternity leave during the summer holidays and will not be back in school during the next academic year. We wish her the very best during what will be a really happy (albeit sleep deprived) time.



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Mr Cartwright will be leaving the school at the end of this term to new beginnings...in fatherhood! We cannot thank Mr Cartwright enough for all the good work he has done to support all of the children in Oak class since his arrival in January. Hopefully our paths will cross again in the future. Timings of the school day

The government recently released guidance that states that all schools must provide a school week of 32.5 hours. In order for us to be compliant with this new expectation, we will be changing the start and end of the school day as set out below:

- 8:40 Doors open (this is when we would prefer children to arrive)
- 8:50 School starts - registration (all children must be here by this time)
- 3:20 School finishes – children dismissed (children to be collected at this time)

These timings are for **all** children. **All** classes have the same school start and finish times.
