Dear Parents/Carers,

Help needed!

Whilst some children have done a brilliant job of learning their lines and are now beginning to act their parts, some children still do not know their lines. This is something I can do very little about; the responsibility of knowing their lines lies with them! If you could help/prod the children to be learning their lines at home, that would be brilliant! On another note, we would appreciate support with costumes and props. We are not necessarily asking people to go out and buy costumes or props, but it would be great if you could have a look around to see if there are any of the items below that you could share with us for the next two weeks. Any items that you do offer up will be kept safe and I guarantee will be returned in the same state they arrived to school in or a replacement offered. If you do send anything in, please put it in a named bag to avoid confusion.

According to the script writers, their **suggestions** for costumes are as follows:

Speaking Character	Costume Suggestions
4 Narrators	White togas and laurel crowns
Zeus	Toga, red robes, gold crown, beard and lightning bolt
Hera	White toga with decorative trim, robes and gold a crown
Athene	White toga, robes, armour, helmet, sword and shield
Aphrodite	Glamorous white dress or toga, tiara and jewellery
A God	White toga, robes and laurel crown
A Goddess	White toga, robes and tiara
Paris	Long blue t-shirt (belted), robes to be removed after scene 1 to be replaced with armour

Menelaus	Long white t-shirt (belted), laurel crown, robes removed after scene 2 to be replaced with armour
Helen	Beautiful dress, tiara and jewellery
Servant to Paris	Long dark t-shirt (belted)
Eros	Oversized white 'nappy', wings, laurel crown, bow and arrow
Guest 1	Long white t-shirt (belted)
Guest 2	Long white t-shirt (belted)
Agamemnon	Long white t-shirt (belted), armour and helmet
Idomeneus	Long white t-shirt (belted), armour and helmet
Philoctetes	Long white t-shirt (belted), armour and helmet
Odysseus	Long white t-shirt (belted), armour, helmet and cloak for scene 7
Diomedes	Long white t-shirt (belted), armour and helmet
Patroclus	Long white t-shirt (belted), armour and helmet
Achilles	Long white t-shirt (belted), armour and helmet
Hector	Long blue t-shirt (belted), armour and helmet
Priam	Long blue t-shirt (belted), crown, and robes
Polyxena	Long blue dress t-shirt, tiara and cloak for scene 5
Trojan 1	Long blue t-shirt (belted) and armour
Trojan 2	Long blue t-shirt (belted) and armour
Trojan 3	Long blue t-shirt (belted) and armour
Trojan 4	Long blue t-shirt (belted) and armour
Trojan 5	Long blue t-shirt (belted) and armour

If we are missing any costumes towards the end of next week, we will definitely source them so please don't worry! With regards to props, we would appreciate any wooden or plastic swords, shields, helmets, bows and arrows and armour. Don't worry if you are not sure if it's appropriate or not, it's better to have more than we need.

Maple Class

We have been so fortunate that Miss Cook and Maple class have helped us out by becoming the choir (and the Trojan Army extras). We would like the children to all wear the same clothing as it is important that all of them look the same. Their 'costume' needs to be a plain black t-shirt and a plain black pair of shorts. Nice and easy!

Performance Dates and Times

The performances will take place on Wednesday July 20th. The first performance is at 1:30 with the second at 6:00. Children will need to be back at school for 5:00 for the second performance. It goes without saying that we need all



of the children back for the second performance! Please let me know if there are any issues preventing your child from coming back for the evening performance.

Tickets

There are a total of 120 tickets available for the performances (60 for each). So that the maximum amount of children can have a known adult present, tickets will be limited to 2 per family in the first instance. Following this, tickets will be distributed. If we are oversubscribed, then preference will be given to Oak class parents first.
