Dear Parents/Carers

The school has arranged a trip to Flag Fen Archaeology Park on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> December to support your child's learning in their work on The Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. This trip will further enhance and deepen the children's learning from the Autumn Term.

The day is fully led by Flag Fen teachers who are all highly experienced, knowledgeable and have a passion for bringing history to life for students of all ages. There will be a mixture of activities ranging from digging and handling artefacts to storytelling in their Bronze Age roundhouse.

To cover the cost of the trip, we would ask for a voluntary contribution of £12.50 to meet some of these costs. We understand that you may be unable to contribute at this time; we also recognise that you may wish to contribute an amount lower than the cost; please make whatever contribution you can afford. If, however, insufficient contributions are received we may need to consider the viability of the trip.

## What to bring:

- Wellington boots in a named bag for exploring the site.
- A plastic bag to sit on outside for lunch. If it is raining or too cold, then we will use an indoor space.
- Long trousers to protect legs against stinging nettles and possible ticks that may be on site.
- Trainers or similar sensible shoes for walking from the coach to our education centre and to wear indoors for hygiene reasons during lunchtime and during activities.
- A raincoat in case of wet weather and enough layers including hat and gloves when seasonally appropriate.
- A packed lunch and drink (Flag Fen are working towards being a nut-free zone- so no nuts please.)

Please also ensure that your child wears their school jumper on the day of the trip.

The trip is running within school hours so your child should still aim to be at school for the normal time of 8:40am. We aim to leave the Flag Fen site at 2:30, so should be back at school for a normal pick-up time of 3:20pm (traffic-permitting).

Please complete and return the slip by no later than the 2<sup>nd</sup> December.

The cost of the trip will be £12.50 per child and this will be payable via Parentpay. Please complete the slip below and return to the school office to confirm that you would like your child to go.
