Another week, yet more events!

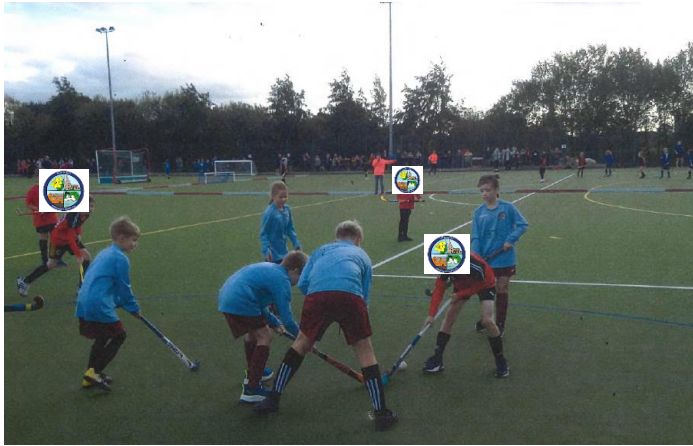
As part of our commitment to broadening our children's awareness of the world around them and celebrating difference, we celebrated Children in Need last week.
