Recently, our choir took ‘action’ and attended the Young Voices concert in Sheffield joining many 1000s of children to make one massive choir.

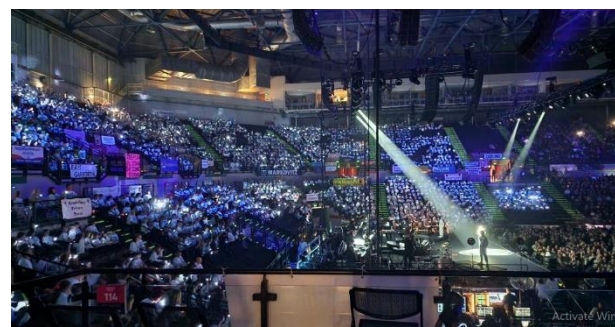
Without doubt, every single child had an amazing and memorable day and for many of them this was an experience that they have not witnessed before.
