MAPLE CLASS

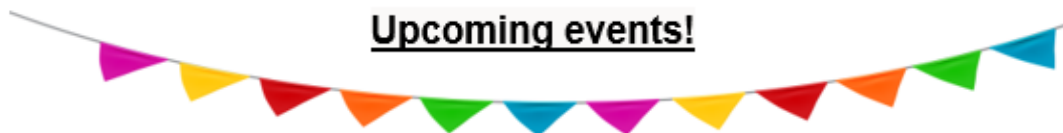
- **Ruby M** for her consistent effort throughout the term, always trying her best and being a kind and responsible individual.
