### **Maple and Oak Class School Trip to Lincoln Museum**

As a school, we always want to enthuse learning and give children as many opportunities as we can to experience the wider world around them. We would therefore like to take the children in Maple and Oak Class to The Lincoln Museum on Wednesday 3rd July to support your child's learning in their work on the Greeks or the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings (Maple) and Greeks (Oak). This trip will further enhance and deepen the children's learning this term.

Part of the day is fully led by Museum teachers who are all highly experienced, knowledgeable and have a passion for bringing history to life for students of all ages. There will be a mixture of activities ranging from digging and handling artefacts to drama about the Greek war.
