In the afternoon, we visited Ferry Meadows for our lunch and to find some wooden sculptures/carvings. Whilst many of our children had visited before, they did not know that such sculptures were in the park. We rounded off our afternoon with children having the opportunity to see these sculptures up close and children in KS2 had the opportunity to create their own sketches. This further developed the skills that we have been working on in art lessons and all of the children were able to revisit and recap these skills in a meaningful context.

MAPLE CLASS


• **Freddie F** for his role-model behaviour during the school trip, being considerate and respectful with his partner and for his increased effort and motivation in class.
