Whilst we <u>have</u> to teach our children how to identify the main garden birds they can see in their locality, we want to take every chance we can to do this kind of learning practically and outside, so this was the perfect way to achieve this learning!

All children had a session outside in the Outdoor Learning Area to see which birds they could see. Beforehand, we held an assembly to find out about the birds they thought they might see and the Wildlife Warriors spent some of their sessions preparing the area to entice the birds to visit: it was clearly a whole







Many children enjoyed this activity and were able to spot some of the birds that we had identified and some that we hadn't. At least no-one thought they saw an eagle this year!
