Work Hard - Be Kind - Achieve

What's been happening in school this week?

In **Assembly,** we have been saying 'Merry Christmas' and learning about Advent. The first week of Advent is about hope and we talked about what this means and how it helps us to achieve. We looked at confidence and how this supports us to work hard and do our very best. Ask the children what they feel confident about and what they lack confidence in: it might surprise you!

In **Willow Class**, children have been learning about the artist Paul Klee and how he constructs portraits using shapes. The children have used photographs of themselves and added shapes to see how they can make their portraits using Paul Klee's style. I can't wait to see their designs and figure out who is who. Why don't you ask your children what shapes they used for their face and why?

In **Maple Class**, children have been continuing their learning in French about animals. This week they learned how to say 'I am' in French and then they had to pretend to be the animals! Would you be able to guess who said, 'Je suis un canard'? What about 'Je suis un lapin'? Can you guess which animal everyone wanted to be: cochon, cheval or vache? Ask your children to see which one they were (and what action they did)!

In **Oak Class**, children have been starting their STEM F1 project. Sounds exciting? Absolutely! The children have been working in groups to design cars that will compete against each other to be judged the best against a set of criteria. This isn't just a school competition. The winning car from our school will go into the regional competition in Boston in January. Ask the children how they feel about the project and see if they know anything about air resistance and downforce.
